Subject: AWARD OF BANKING SERVICES CONTRACT

Recommended Motion:

MOVE TO APPROVE A CONTRACT WITH US BANK FOR BANKING AND PROCUREMENT CARD SERVICES FOR DECEMBER 1, 2019 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024 AND UP TO 5 ONE-YEAR EXTENSIONS AND AUTHORIZE STAFF TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS.

Background/Discussion:

The City published a request for proposals (RFP) for banking, procurement card, and merchant services on August 16, 2019 and received 6 proposals that met the mandatory requirements. City Staff in the Finance Department evaluated the proposals based on four sets of criteria: (1) Mandatory Criteria, (2) Customer Service, (3) Expertise and Experience, and (4) Fees. The rankings of the proposals are as follows:

During Staff's evaluation, US Bank's proposal was given the most points. Particularly in the area of fees, US Bank obtained the highest scores as a result of having the lowest bank fees, a high earnings credit, and a procurement card solution with a high rebate for spend. Staff recommends award of the contract for banking and purchasing card services to US Bank. However, Staff recommends keeping our current merchant services provider through Chase Paymentech as it remains more competitive than US Bank's option.

The contract term was specified in the RFP is five (years), starting with December 1, 2019 and ending with November 30, 2024. After this initial term, the contract allows for up to 5 additional one-year extensions subject to the approval of the City's Finance Director and bank.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends award of the banking services and procurement card contract to US Bank and keeping Chase Paymentech for merchant services.

Financial Impact:

Various service fees are charged for commercial banking services. These fees can be covered by maintaining a balance in the account which earn a specific earnings credit, called compensating balances, or the City will be invoiced for these fees. The itemized fees charged by US Bank are less than our current provider and US Bank offers more earnings credit on compensating balances. Also, the procurement card service offered by US Bank has rebates on spend. US Bank will provide the City with more cost effective services.
